

Instructions on Proceedings, Presentations, and Pre-recorded Videos

1. Inclusion of Papers in Proceedings of COBEE2022

COBEE2022-accepted papers can be published in *Springer Nature* (EI and Scopus indexed) as Proceedings of COBEE2022. If you wish to publish your paper (3-page extended abstracts or 8- page full papers) in *Springer Nature*, please:

- 1) Sign Licence to Publish Proceedings Papers (download from [here](#) under `PROCEEDINGS – LICENCE OF PUBLICATION`) by the corresponding author and submit it through the [conftool](#) (Your submissions/Final Upload) before **July 11, 2022**.
- 2) Please note that To be published in the proceeding, at least one of the authors needs to register for the conference.
- 3) In License to Publish Proceedings Papers, the title of the paper, full name(s) of authors, and the name of the corresponding author should be filled on the first page,
- 4) The corresponding author needs to provide the personal information and sign on the last page on behalf of all other authors (page 5).

2. Presentations

- 2) Once your presentation is complete, please upload it [here](#). This step **must be completed one week before the conference begins** to make sure your presentation slides are available during your session

3. Pre-recorded Presentations

Pre-recorded presentations are required for all virtual presentations. Your presentation recording should be a screen recording of your PPT slides with you presenting as a voice-over. All recordings should be submitted on [conftool](#) (Your submissions/Final Upload) in MP4 file format **before July 11th 2022**

IMPORTANT: Do not record your screen with a higher resolution than 1920 × 1080. If your computer's resolution is higher than that, please change this to a maximum of 1920 × 1080.

To record your presentation, please use one of the recommended recording software:

- 1) For Windows or Mac -- Zoom Meeting Application (<https://zoom.us/download>, free account), and submit the recording on [conftool](#) as a **MP4 recording (no other video format will be accepted)**
- 2) For Windows or Mac -- TechSmith Snagit (<https://www.techsmith.com/screen-capture.html>, free 15-day trial), and submit the recording on [conftool](#) as a **MP4 recording**.
